The District of Columbia (DC) Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) has implemented the DC Insurance Verification System (DCIIS) in order to verify automobile liability insurance for vehicles registered in DC. DC's Compulsory/No-Fault Motor Vehicle Insurance Act <https://code.dccouncil.us/dc/council/code/titles/31/chapters/24/> requires you to maintain liability insurance on vehicles registered in DC.

It has been determined for the vehicle listed above that you have cancelled insurance with **Lucinda Insurance Co.** on 01/01/2018 and obtained new insurance with **Darnell Insurance Co.** on 1/30/2018.

This reflects a lapse in insurance coverage from 01/01/2018 to 01/30/2018. A \$150 fee is required for any insurance lapse from 1-30 days, and \$7 per day for each day after 30, up to a \$2,500 maximum. To avoid suspension of your vehicle's registration, you must respond to this letter in one of the following methods by 3/10/2018:

- Pay the required fee. This fee can be paid online using the www.DCIIS.org website and the reference number at the top of this letter or at any DMV Service Center,

Or

- If you had insurance during this lapse period, you must contact your insurance company or agent. Your insurance company or agent must electronically submit your insurance information to DCIIS using the www.DCIIS.org website and the reference number at the top of this letter.

If you fail to satisfy the above requirements by 03/10/2018, your vehicle registration will be suspended per DC law. If your vehicle registration is suspended, you will be assessed an additional \$98 reinstatement fee. You can check the status of your suspension at any time using the www.DCIIS.org website and the reference number at the top of this letter.
